### JJC Baseball Coaching Staff

**Head Coach: Wayne L. King, Jr.:** King has guided his teams to nine national tournaments, thirteen NJCAA Region IV titles and seven North Central Community College championships. In the past five years, JJC has finished with a 216-87 record with a national title and a second, third and fourth place finish at the NJCAA Division III World Series. With 35 wins in 2010, that marked the 20th straight season the Wolves have posted 30 or more victories in a season. The Wolves coaching staff has produced 34 All-Americans and over 185 of the players have gone on to play at four-year colleges. Without question, King's coaching success has not gone unnoticed. He has been voted Coach of the Year in the competitive N4C conference six times. For the Wolves success in 1994 and 2008, he was named NJCAA Division III National Coach of the Year, Coach of the Year for the Division III World Series and District Coach of the Year. King was inducted into the Region IV Hall of Fame by his fellow Region IV athletic directors as an administrator/coach in 2004. In May 2009, King received a great honor of being inducted into the NJCAA Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame. The JJC Board of Trustees named the baseball field Wayne L. King, Jr. Field in June 2009.

**Assistant Head Coach: Gregg Braun:** The 2011 season will be Gregg Braun's third season at Joliet Junior College as the Assistant Head Baseball Coach. He is in charge of the JJC Wolves pitching and catching staff. During his first year, he helped lead the Wolves to a fourth-place finish at the NJCAA Division III World Series. The team finished with a 41-17 overall record. In 2010, the Wolves finished with a 35-24 record. He spent the 2007 and 2008 baseball seasons as the assistant varsity baseball coach at his alma mater, Providence Catholic High School in New Lenox, IL. Prior to coaching at Providence, he spent one year at Romeoville High School as an assistant varsity baseball coach and a year at Lemont High School where he was a freshman assistant coach.
